South River Road Closure

2017 FLOOD SEASON

- South River Road (SRR) has been closed at Gregory Avenue, Davis Road, Linden Road, and Locks Drive due to the severe winter weather, saturated levee conditions and some erosion and continued erosion potential along the levee due to high river levels and will remain closed until the end of the 2017 flood season (when river levels recede below elevation 19, estimated around June 1st).
- South River Road is currently open to local traffic only (marinas and residents).
- Fishermen that are currently accessing this stretch of the Sacramento River are parking primarily on the connecting streets at the closure points (Linden Road and Davis Road). Parking at this location will continue to be allowed until the two roads are permanently closed for levee construction which is anticipated to be around June 1st.

2017 CONSTRUCTION SEASON

- **South River Road from Locks Drive to Davis Road:** Access at the north end at Locks Drive will remain available throughout the 2017 construction season. There will be a Road Closed sign placed at Locks Drive, indicating local access only (this will include fisherman starting June 1st). **This segment of roadway, although providing local access, will NOT be maintained by the City and users will be accessing this roadway at their own risk (this will be noted on informational signs to be installed at the road closure).**
- **Closure of Linden Road and Davis Road at intersection with South River Road:** With construction of the setback levee scheduled to start around June 1st, the eastern limits of these roadways at SRR will be closed with the construction of temporary gravel cul-de-sacs. Parking will not be permitted at the cul-de-sacs and proper signage will be installed. Access for the marinas after the Linden Road and Davis Road closures, will be via the north end at Locks Drive and will remain open until completion of the new access roads from Village Parkway which is anticipated around April 2018. Since SRR will become a dead end roadway, a turnaround configuration will be provided at South River Road/Davis Road for Fire equipment and vehicle turnaround.
- **Closure of South River Road from Davis Road to Gregory Avenue:** This closure is currently in place as of the first week of April for tree removal and demolition work (**NO PUBLIC ACCESS ALLOWED**). This closure will remain in place indefinitely.

PROJECT INFORMATION

The Southport Levee Improvement Project will implement flood risk-reduction measures along one of the most vulnerable levee segments along the Sacramento River in the Southport area of the City of West Sacramento. The Project extends along the west bank of the Sacramento River, from just south of the Barge Canal, downstream 5.6 miles to the South Cross Levee. The proposed levee improvements include but are not limited to construction of levee embankment, cutoff walls and/or seepage berms, with associated clearing, grubbing, stripping, utility relocation, demolition, rock slope protection, roadway realignment/relocation, new access ramps and roads, turnouts, cul-de-sacs, and maintenance corridors. The Project will bring this section of levee up to current standards with Federal and State levee criteria, as well as provide opportunities for ecosystem restoration and public recreation.
