

**ORDER 20-01 OF THE DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES
OF THE CITY OF WEST SACRAMENTO**

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2020, the City Council of the City of West Sacramento adopted Resolution 20-65 proclaiming a state of local emergency and imposing a curfew throughout the City of West Sacramento based on looting and vandalism within the City that had begun on May 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 20-65 delegated authority to the Director of Emergency Services to modify the hours of the curfew as necessary to protect public safety;

WHEREAS, after consulting with West Sacramento public safety personnel and the City of Sacramento, I have determined that modifications to the hours of the curfew are appropriate.

NOW, THEREFORE, I hereby modify the curfew imposed by Resolution 20-65 as follows:

1. The curfew is suspended throughout the City of West Sacramento until 10:00 p.m., June 5, 2020.
2. Beginning June 5, the hours of the curfew are modified to extend from 10:00 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.
3. Except as otherwise provided herein, all other terms of the curfew imposed by Resolution 20-65 remain in full force and effect.
