



## 3 Safe Disposal Options for Prescription & Over-the-Counter Medications!

1. **Jefferson Pharmacy, (Medicine disposal is back!)** 1029 Jefferson Blvd, Suite A, Monday -Friday, (10am to 5pm)
2. **West Sacramento Police Station,** 550 Jefferson Blvd, Monday -Friday, (8am to 5pm)
3. **Walgreens Pharmacy,** 1351 W Capitol Ave, West Sacramento, CA 95691, Monday - Sunday, (8am to 10pm)

### How does it Work?

Remove any personal information from prescription containers.

#### Pill Disposal

- Remove pills from their container and place in a clear sealed bag.
- Drop off the sealed bag in the medication bin at one of the 3 bin locations.
- Recycle the empty pill bottles in your curbside recycling bin.

#### Liquids and Creams

- Keep in original container and place entire container in the medication bin.

#### What can go in the bins?

Prescription medications  
Over-the-counter medications  
Medicated ointments and lotions  
Pet medications

**YES!**

#### What can't go in the bins?

Sharps  
Inhalers  
Cannabis Products  
Hazardous Waste  
Bandages/Biological Waste
