PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Southport Levee Improvement Project is
approximately 29,300 lineal feet (5.5 miles) of flood
protection construction. The project levee
improvements have been described in preliminary
evaluations to include seven (7) segments, Segments A
through G. Levee improvement will include but is not
limited to construction of levee embankment, cutoff
walls and/or seepage berms, with associated clearing,
grubbing, stripping, utility relocation, demolition, rock
slope protection, staging areas, borrow sites, and utility
corridors. Project transportation improvements include
realigned roadways, new access ramps and roads,
turnouts, cul-de-sacs, and maintenance corridors.

A meeting will be held for the purpose of reviewing and answering questions regarding this project. Attendance of this meeting is encouraged for any General Contractor submitting a bid and Cutoff wall subcontractors. Attendance will be documented on a sign in sheet provided by the Agency. Any interested contractor or his/her agent may attend. Representatives of WSAFCA will be present for questions.

Award of contract requires the bidder to have a valid California Contractor's License with the classification identified above. All Cutoff wall Subcontractors shall also be required to meet the minimum qualifications identified in Division 31 of the Technical Specifications. Award of this contract also requires the bidder to demonstrate qualifications to perform the required work based upon having successfully installed cutoff walls in similar materials with the physical properties, lengths, and depths required for this project.

Each Bid must be submitted on the bid forms provided herein. Each bid must also be accompanied by security in the form of a bid bond issued by a corporate surety, a certified check or cashier's check payable to WSAFCA, or cash for an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the aggregate sum of the bid.

The successful Bidder shall be required to execute a Material and Labor Payment Bond and a Performance Bond, issued by a corporate surety, acceptable to WSAFCA, each for not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the original Total Contract Price.

WSAFCA encourages the submission of bids and sub-bids by minority-owned and woman-owned business enterprises.

A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of any contract for public work, as defined in this chapter, unless currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5. It is not a violation of this section for an unregistered contractor to submit a bid that is authorized by Section 7029.1 of the Business and Professions Code or by Section 10164 or 20103.5 of the Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 at the time the contract is awarded.

This is a construction project in accordance with Section 1771.5 of the California Labor Code. This contract is subject to: (1) Federal Labor Standards Provisions as required by the Davis-Bacon Act and other applicable Federal requirements, (2) Equal Employment Opportunity requirements pursuant to Executive Order 11246, and (3) Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) development pursuant to Executive Order 12432.

All labor on the project shall be paid no less than the minimum wage rates as established by the U.S. Secretary of Labor or as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. The higher of the two rates will be paid in accordance with the following acts and codes:

- (1) The Davis-Bacon Act, and
- (2) Section 1770, and following, of the California Labor Code.
