A. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS RESPONSE OR ABATING FEES

1. Costs for mitigating an incident involving a hazardous materials spill. Standby fee for the protection of life, property and the environment during a potentially dangerous act involving hazardous materials.

**C. SERVICE FEE**

Service fees will be charged on a time and materials basis. Hourly billing rates are determined from time to time by the City Work Order System. These rates cover direct labor, M&O and overhead and will be updated at the time of review.
